1. Call to Order by Chair Nick Wagner at 7:50

2. **Meditation:** Tim Slezak

3. **Commission Reports:** Christian Service, Finance, Faith Formation, and Stewardship.

4. **Athletic Association Report:** We have a new representative from the Association, Ben Deyarmond. They have not had a meeting yet, but he informed us they have selected a new president. They will also have new people in charge of their fish fries.

5. **Dare to Dream:** *Sharon Pagryzinski:* Get minutes from other commissions sooner. *Pete Steyer:* Move crucifix into church proper. *Bob Campbell:* Have hand rail leading up to the Altar.

6. **Good News!:** Justified Quartet is coming to the parish. Advertising is in several places around town. It was also sent to all local parishes. The church looks good inside and out. It is always clean and well kept.

7. **Approval of Minutes from May 9, 2018 and June 13, 2018:** Approved, no changes

8. **Pastor's Report:**

a. **Sale of Fr. Emmett's House:** After a survey and bids were returned, a fence will be put up around the property. There is interest in the home. It will be sold as is, no repairs.

b. **St. Hedwig Campus:** The official decree was received from the Diocese to announce the approval of the sale. It must be posted for viewing. It is currently up in the church and the bulletin. There is expressed interest in the property. The Diocese has not given a price at this point in time. No sacred items will be removed until there is a contract and the property is sold. With no sacred items, the property can become subject to tax. There will be a final Mass celebrated at a later date. The rectory needs to be emptied and minor repair work done before the sale.

c. **Vincent House:** The house was repaired and repainted on the outside. Windows were repaired as well. The cost was nearly double, as many unexpected needs surfaced.

10. **Information items:**

a. **Appreciation Dinner:** The Appreciation Dinner is September 21, 2018. It is catered and the theme is "Thanks a Latte." Volunteers to help the office staff are always appreciated.

11. **Discussion Items:**

a. **Air conditioning in the Social Hall:** It has been tossed around about getting air in the hall for some time. At this time, the hall and school will be in need of a new boiler. It would make more sense to have a new boiler versus air because it is colder outside, more than it is hot. It is not possible to have air installed with a boiler.

b. **Funeral Luncheons:** Things are going well. Families are asked for a donation and for it to be turned into the office. The goal essentially with the budget is to breakeven.

12. Action Items:

a. Promote *Rebuilt*: Ask for volunteers, specially “target” people to be involved. Look for a variety of people. At this time, focus on *Rebuilt* and not on Amazing Parishes.

b. Focus on Life Dinner is October 2, 2018 at 5:30. Parish Council purchased a table. It was suggested that it be advertised on the sign.

c. Enrichment Day is November 3 for the entire Diocese.
